Parent and Participants,

To help our Teen Lock-In run smoothly, we want to review our expectations so that parents and teens understand YMCA policies. As with any Y program we expect each participant to practice the values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility and Faith.

1. The doors open at 8:45 pm.
2. Teens may enter until 10:00 PM. If you have a prior commitment and will need to arrive later please speak with Jenny to make arrangements prior to the lock-in.
3. All of your belongings should be kept in a locker. The locker rooms are locked from 9:30 pm-12:00 am, and opened for swimming (12:00-3:00 am) and locked again from 3:15-6:30 am. We encourage use of locks.
4. **For the safety of everyone's personal items we encourage you to leave expensive items at home.**
5. **The YMCA adheres to a dress code similar to that of the schools. Short shorts and camisoles will not be permitted, as well as any clothing with inappropriate language and/or graphics.**
6. Teens that become ill or misbehave may be sent home after Lindsay speaks to a parent.
7. **Cell Phones are permitted, however between 12:00 am and 6:30 am they must be in a locker; if teens use cell phones during these hours, they will be held at the Courtesy Counter until after the event.**
8. Pizza and pop are provided around midnight. While we have vending machines, we can't guarantee they will be refilled by the night of the lock-in. **You must bring your own change or small bills (\$1) for vending. We cannot provide change.**
9. Sleeping is allowed; however, most teens decide not to sleep. The north hallway is reserved for any sleepers.
10. **Students are dismissed beginning at 6:45 am. Pick up is in the north lot. Please pull forward as much as possible so traffic isn't backed up on the street. Traffic cannot be at a stop on St Rt. 198. Teens MAY NOT meet parents at Marathon. Teens are not permitted to meet vehicles on the road. Teens MAY NOT walk home after dismissal. Please make sure all parents are aware of who is taking them home.**
11. We expect all of our participants to be Caring, Honest, Respectful and Responsible at all times toward staff, volunteers, other participants and to the YMCA property.
12. We do not allow swearing, fighting, misbehaving or horseplay. Teens are not allowed on the Track or in the Wellness Center.
13. Candy, food and pop must stay in the lobby. Gum is NOT allowed in the YMCA.
14. Every student **MUST** have their own permission slip with a parent signature. Bringing exact change or a check helps the registration/sign in process move much faster.
